HEALTH CAMPS FOR THE UNDERPRIVILEGED

Max India Foundation has collaborated with ILA Trust (an NGO which runs 3 mobile clinic vans) to provide free medicines every month to the needy people from the underserved communities of Delhi (Okhla, Jama Masjid, Ajmeri Gate, Baratooti, Shastri Park, GB Road, Turkman Gate, Sarai Khalil, Fatehpuri, Chawri Bazaar, Jamuna Bazaar and Lahori Gate) at health camps. Max India Foundation has provided free medicines to **14749 people** in the month of August through ILA Trust.



IN ADDITION, 18 HEALTH CAMPS WERE ORGANIZED IN THE MONTH OF AUGUST. WE HAVE REACHED OUT TO 108555 PEOPLE THROUGH 514 HEALTH CAMPS TO DATE.

HEALTH AWARENESS

- A film on **Cancer Awareness** was screened for **120 women** during the cancer awareness cum detection camps organized in association with NGO Gianelli Sadan and Sshrishti Learning Centre.
- A puppet show on **Health and Hygiene** was organized for **800 children** of NGO Niveda in Noida.
- A puppet show on **Prevention of Dengue** was performed for **440 children** of NGO Guru Garib Niwaz Society in GK-2, SETU in Noida, Samarpan Foundation in Kotla Mubarakpur and Khushii in Deoli village.
- **102 children** were educated on importance of nutrition, **18 children** were educated on importance of hand washing, **14 women** were educated in first aid procedures, **175 women** were educated on anaemia and **10** were educated on hygiene during the camps organized in Dhakrani, Dehradun.

IMMUNIZATION CAMPS

MIF through its Pan - India Immunization program has reached out to **50292 children** (some have received multiple shots) through **830 camps**.

21 immunization camps were organized in the month of August.

767 children were given deworming tablets and **1567 children** were given Vitamin – A tablets.

PROGRESS ON VILLAGE ADOPTION PROJECT AT DHAKRANI, DEHRADUN

Since adopting the village earlier this year, MIF has organized **31 Biweekly camps** in association with Bella Health Care Charitable Trust reaching out to **2199 villagers, 761 children** have received MMR vaccination through **7 immunization camps** and **5 Multi Speciality Camps** have been organized in association with Max Healthcare, Dehradun benefitting **1458 villagers**.

Besides this, tree plantation drive was initiated in the month of August. The Sarpanch and villagers have taken the task to plant **1000 saplings** in and around the village. **400 saplings** have already been planted. Plantations have been done in schools, Panchayat Ghar and roadside. Each ward member has been given the responsibility to take care of the planted saplings. Educational banners in hindi on nutrition, hand washing and quit smoking have been put up in the Panchayat Ghar.

The work on the Sewerage and Sanitation Project is progressing well.

SUPPORT FOR SURGERIES AND TREATMENT

- In August, **21 paediatric cardiac surgeries** were conducted by Dr. Dagar and team for children referred by Genesis Foundation and Afghan Red Crescent Society for surgical correction of congenital heart anomalies at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- MIF facilitated treatment for **7 patients** suffering from different ailments including (premature baby provided medical care, kidney stone, stomach cancer, spondylitis, brain tumor, reconstructive surgery of the face and medical management) at Max Hospitals (Pitampura, Saket and Dehradun).
- **2 cases** from Village Dhakrani were referred to Max Hospital, Dehradun for coronary artery bypass surgery.
- MIF facilitated free consultations (dermatologist) for **2 children** of NGO Tara Homes at Max Hospital, Panchsheel and arranged free consultation and investigations for **2 cases** referred by NGO Samarpan (suffering from ovarian cyst and kidney stone) at Max Hospital, Patparganj.
- A young boy referred by NGO Tara Homes underwent pacemaker implantation at Max Hospital, Saket.
- A young girl referred by NGO CanKids...KidsCan underwent chemotherapy at Max Hospital, Bhatinda.
- MIF in association with The Hans Foundation facilitated **6 cochlear** implant surgeries at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- **13 Pap smear tests** were conducted at Max Hospital, West Block, Saket for patients identified at the cancer screening camps organized in Delhi.

Max India Foundation has sponsored 4474 surgeries and treatments to date. A big thank you to all our doctors and their teams for their support.

SUPPORT THROUGH MIF'S HEALTH CENTRES

737 people benefitted through our health centre in Rail Majra, Punjab, **387** in Ukimath, **584** at Antara camp site and **105** at our Mussoorie health centre. **100 children** supported at Jamghat Day Care centre for street children for nutrition, learning and vocational skills every month. **800 people** provided medical assistance and healthcare facilities through Chinmaya Health Centre, Sunlight colony, New Delhi every month.

SUPPORT THROUGH PARTNER NGOS

- Cancer care provided to **12 patients** and **212 home** visits conducted through NGO CanSupport, **24 children** provided free boarding and lodging at the St Jude India Child Care Centre, Noida. **6 HPV/DNA** tests conducted through Indian Cancer Society.
- **40 young girls** from urban slum communities undergoing General Duty Attendant Training at Ranhaulla.
- Free medicinal support provided every month to **400 people** through NGO India Foundation and **100 children** through Palna in New Delhi.
- Regular nutritional support given to **100 children** through NGO partner Rittana Childrens Foundation in Noida and **300 children** of Purkal Youth Development Society in Dehradun.
- **9649** benefitted through the Traditional Birth Attendant Training program organized in association with NGO Sewa Mandir in Udaipur and Academy of Management Studies in Uttarakhand.
