# **MULTI SPECIALITY HEALTH CAMPS**

#### **DFHRADUN**

- MIF in association with Max Hospital, Dehradun conducted a camp on 1st Feb 2015 for 72 children of NGO Balika Niketan.
- Max India Foundation in association with Max Healthcare and Max Life Insurance organized a camp on 25 Feb in village Dhakrani. Doctors of Max Hospital, Dehradun examined 380 villagers across all age groups. Free medicines were provided to the needy. Blood sugar and BP were also checked by the nurses of Max hospital. Many thanks to the dedicated team of MLIC volunteers, doctors and nurses from Max Healthcare who gave their unconditional support in this camp.

#### REWARI, ROHTAK, NUH AND JHAJJAR

- 2 Multi speciality health camps were organized on 4th and 11th Feb in association with NGO Youthreach benefitting 468 people and one camp organized with NGO Chetnalaya on 19th Feb benefitting 200 people in Rewari.

All the beneficiaries received free consultations. BP, weight and random blood sugar were also checked and free medicines were provided to the needy.

#### **DELHI AND NCR**

- 25 Multi speciality camps were organized through our NGO partners/ Banjara Mahila, Chetnalaya, Art of Living, Khushii, Avon, Tata Powers, Gianelli Sadan, Mobile Creche and Samarpan Foundation across Delhi, Gurgaon and Noida. Total 3420 people received free consultations. BP, weight and random blood sugar were also checked and free medicines were provided to the needy.
- 2 Eye camps were organized in association with NGO partners/ Nulife and Shine Foundation in Gurgaon and Noida benefitting 265 people. Free medicines were also provided.
- 3 Dental check camps were organized in association with Steria Foundation, Gianelli Sadan and Shine Foundation in Noida benefitting 285 people.
- 1 ENT check camp was organized on 25th Feb in association with Om Indu Rural Hospital in Gurgaon. Free consultations were provided to 53 people. BP, weight and random blood sugar were also checked and free medicines were provided to the needy.
- Regular health check up done for 25 children of NGO Jamghat at their Lado Sarai centre.

## **IMMUNIZATION CAMPS**

**26 immunization camps were successfully conducted** this month through our NGO partners/ Khushii, Steria Foundation, Bharti Foundation, Banjara Mahila, Art of Living, Gianelli Sadan, Shine Foundation, Sunaay Foundation, Guru Garib Niwaz Society, Rasta, KISS, Happy School, Umeed Ghar, Nulife and Bella Healthcare. These camps were conducted in Delhi, Noida, Gurgaon, Dehradun, Bhubneshwar and Pune. 786 children were given Vitamin A and De-worming tablets.
