India is likely to have over 17.3 lakh new cases of cancer and over 8.8 lakh deaths due to the disease by 2020 with cancers of breast, lung and cervix topping the list.

Max India Foundation has aggressively supported and initiated various cancer related activities which include cancer awareness, diagnostic and preventive measures and support for cancer treatment.

4th Feb being World Cancer Day, various activities were planned around the cancer theme which included our participation in the CanSupport Walk for Life, an awareness initiative which is being supported for the last 10 years. A Cancer Screening camp to detect symptoms of oral, breast and cervical cancer was organized in Dakshinpuri on 17th Feb benefitting 119 people. 61 Pap smear tests and 7 mammographies were also done. 500 people in Dwarka and Nazafgarh were sensitized on Tobacco menace through a Puppet Show on 16th Feb organized in association with the Delhi Police and Sambandh Healthcare Foundation. MIF has recently initiated a HPV awareness drive which aims to educate women on its prevention and vaccination since it is considered a leading cause of cervical cancer among women. 5 HPV and Cervical Cancer awareness camps were organized benefitting 276 young girls and women across Delhi NCR.



Honoured at the World CSR Congress, Mumbai

Mrs. Mohini Daljeet Singh was conferred with the "Global CSR Leadership Award" on the occasion of World CSR Day on 17th & 18th Feb. She spoke on Purposeful Purpose and moderated a session on Incorporating CSR in Corporate Strategy. The event was well attended by Corporate CSR Heads, NGOs from across the country and several representatives from Global Social organizations.



February celebrated as the Max-Raphael Partnership month

It has been 7 years of wonderful partnership between Max and Raphael providing excellent quality care to the challenged children and adults, TB patients and other residents of Raphael Centre. An immunization camp was organized on 23rd Feb at Hasanpur Primary School, Jattowala Primary School, Sabbawala Primary School and Dandapur Primary School where Dr Harshita and Nurses Priya Parmar, Shalu and Sweta from MSSH Dehradun administered typhoid vaccination to 270 children. A cataract check up camp was held at Raphael on 28th Feb benefitting approximately 175 people.

The artificial limbs camp that is scheduled to be part of the MIF Raphael partnership month activities will be held from 10th-13th April 2018. A 3 day workshop is also planned from 5th-7th March on 'Introduction and Challenges to Inclusive Education' for 30 special educators and the resource persons.
