**Ensuring Warmth** - 100 blankets were donated for NGO Ritinjali, and 102 woolen caps for NGO Delhi Association for the Deaf.

300 sweaters were distributed for students of Government Primary School Latherdeva Hoon and Government Primary School Gadarjuda, Roorkee.

Clothes for adults and children were collected and distributed to the needy by Max Hospital, Pitampura, New Delhi.

**A glimpse on various initiatives conducted at our Adopted Village clusters - Dhakrani and Guniyal Gaon.**



**Dhakrani, Dehradun and Guniyal Gaon**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> round of home visits conducted on Jan 20<sup>th</sup> - 100 households provided awareness on waste management, cleanliness, hygiene and introduced to financial literacy. The importance of "Swachh Raho Swasth Raho," was highlighted.
- Regular immunisation for children and bi weekly health camps organised, benefitting 960 villagers. A multi speciality camp was organised in association with Max Healthcare and Max Life Insurance on Jan 19<sup>th</sup>, benefitting 312 villagers.
- Health awareness programs on back pain, hand washing/oral hygiene, MMR and female foeticide organised, benefitting 591 women and children.

- Library books from NGO Pratham and sports equipment (Cricket, Badminton, Football, etc.) were provided to the Government School at Dhakrani Village and Guniyal Gaon.
- On Jan 21<sup>st</sup>, a session on Injury Prevention Program was organised and 70 students of the Guniyal Gaon Government School were trained.
- A lady cleaner has been engaged to clean the toilets/classrooms daily at Government School, Guniyal Gaon. A large room in the GG school is being renovated and set up as an Audio- Visual room to complement class room teaching.

## GENERAL HEALTH AWARENESS

- A film was screened on Menstrual Hygiene and an interactive session conducted for 50 young girls on Jan 27<sup>th</sup>, through NGO Project Concern International in Seemapuri.
- 60 women were educated on Breast and Cervical Cancer at the Cancer Awareness Camp at Shine Foundation on Jan 27<sup>th</sup>.
- A talk on First Aid was conducted for 100 girls, at Kilkari Home on Jan 12<sup>th</sup>.

MAX INDIA FOUNDATION HAS SPONSORED **4,966** SURGERIES AND TREATMENTS TO DATE.

Surgeries supported in the month of January:

- MIF provided treatment support for **6** patients suffering from ailments (renal disease, cancer of cervix, accident case, brain hemorrhage, hernia and head injury) at Max Hospital in Saket - New Delhi, Dehradun and Bhatinda.
- ENT and Eye consultation was facilitated through MIF for **2** children referred by NGO Tara at Max Hospital in Saket and Panchsheel. BERA test was done for a child referred by NGO Tara at Max Hospital, Saket, New Delhi.
- **4** paediatric cardiac surgeries were conducted by Dr. Dagar and team for surgical correction of congenital heart anomalies at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket, New Delhi.
- **29** cataract surgeries were facilitated through MIF at Max Hospital, Mohali for cases identified at a health camp in Toansa village, Punjab.
