But post surgery, the diagnosis of a persistent pain revealed that the plate joining the fractured bone was broken and would be fixed by another operation. Plunged in misery and financial crisis, his worried wife sought help. MIF came on board and facilitated Daniel's surgery. Today, he is walking normally and is fully recovered.
