**March 2019 has been a month of memorable milestones for Max India Foundation. Here is an overview:**

### **Healing with hope**

Max India Foundation's first Prosthesis Camp at Ropar, Punjab witnessed 162 beneficiaries receive prosthetic limbs-61 artificial limbs were donated, 78 callipers and 23 crutches were given to the needy. This was in collaboration with NGO Manav Seva Sannidhi.

Months ago, an elderly woman Dhapu was hit and run over by a speeding car in South Delhi. Not only did she lose mobility but the accident impacted her earnings as a daily wage worker. She had sustained a hip bone fracture. On 10<sup>th</sup> March 2019, her family approached MIF for help, during an International Women's Day programme organised by South Delhi Lodhi Road (SODELO) near Tyagraj Stadium. After meeting Ms Mohini Daljeet Singh, CEO of Max India Foundation, the ailing woman was provided a new wheelchair within 3 days. She has regained mobility and her confidence!

## Story OF Hope

Six months after Alka was born, her father a low-income farmer from Bihar detected a lump in her hand. Alarmed, he rushed her to a local doctor who prescribed a homeopathic treatment. When this didn't work, Alka's family tried allopathic medicines but to no avail. Finally, when Alka was rushed to a health camp in Nalanda, a tumor was confirmed. The infant was taken to AIIMS Patna where she underwent surgery on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2018. Because of her tender age, chemotherapy and radiation were ruled out and post surgery the lump returned. Determined to get rid of the tumor, the father used all his resources and approached MIF through Cankids. MIF facilitated the surgery and today, Alka is tumor free.
