World No Tobacco Day

Max India Foundation organized **6 Tobacco Awareness cum Oral Health Check-up Camps** in the month of May benefiting **950 people**. These were targeted to benefit a spectrum of population including women, adolescent children as well as communities. Several tools such as interactive sessions, flip-book and puppet shows were used to stress upon the harmful effects of tobacco and encourage cessation.

Update from our Adopted Village Rail Majra in Punjab

The boundary wall of the Govt School in Rail Majra was constructed with support from MIF. This will enable the authorities to keep stray animals out and plant some trees. This was a long standing request. A fully equipped interactive Science Lab has been set up for the students. Both these projects were inaugurated on 7th May.



The 1st Batch of class 12 of the Govt School passed with flying colors with girls topping. As a token of encouragement, the top 4 girl students were rewarded by MIF. Mrs. Mohini Daljeet Singh - CEO Max India Foundation interacted with the students. She encouraged them to work hard to fulfill their dreams and aspirations.

Vaccination Schedule completed for girls at Balgram, Sonipat

It has been more than a year, since Team MIF, has been conducting immunization for the girls at Balgram, Sonipat, a Home for orphans and the destitute. On 5th May, 3rd dose of Hep B vaccination was given to 100 girls. **This finally completes the vaccination schedule (MMR/DT/Typhoid/Hep B) for the girls, providing them with lifelong immunity against the disease.**



Healthy Children, Healthy Future

Max India Foundation through its partner NGOs strongly propagates the importance and provides support for nutritious food for children. On May 10th, a Health talk was organized for 60 students of Guniyal Gaon Govt School by Dr. Soumya from Max Super Speciality Hospital, Dehradun. She spoke on various nutrition issues like healthy eating habits, avoiding junk food, importance of breakfast, cleanliness etc.
