#### **OUR SEVABHAV...**

1. Max India Foundation organised its 8th Annual Artificial Limbs and Polio Calipers Camp in association with Manav Seva Sannidhi from – November 19 to 22, at Raphael Centre, Dehradun. 181 people from Dehradun, Mussoorie and the surrounding villages registered to avail free services during the camp. 129 artificial limbs, 86 calipers and 4 crutches were given away to the patients. Volunteers from Max entities in Dehradun – Max Life Insurance, Max Healthcare and Antara Senior Living, wholeheartedly provided support for all the 4 days. The initiative was widely appreciated. Thank you everyone for maintaining the true spirit of 'SEVABHAV'.









The month was also celebrated as the Max Raphael partnership month. MIF supported all Raphael Centre initiatives providing support for children with special needs and TB patients.

2. On November 28, a team of 50 Max Life Insurance employees and agent advisors volunteered to visit 100 households, door to door, of our adopted village Dhakrani for more personalised interaction to reiterate the awareness and lessons they have been taught on waste management, cleanliness, hygiene, and introduce them to financial literacy. The importance of 'Swatchh Raho Swasth Raho' was also highlighted. Each household visited was given a gift and there was great excitement among the volunteers and the villagers.





3. Team Antara came together maintaining the true spirit of sharing and spreading love by celebrating 'Joy of Giving', in Delhi and Dehradun. Ration and quilts were collected and given away to children from NGO Khushi in Delhi and Cheshire Home in Dehradun. They were happy to spend quality time with children.



4. 106 Max Life Insurance employees voluntarily participated in the Blood Donation Camp organised in association with Rotary Club in their Gurgaon office (60 employees at 90A facility & 46 employees a DLF, Jacaranda office) on November 5.



5. To beat the winter blues, MIF donated 250 blankets for the underserved through NGO ILA Trust. A wheelchair was donated to Agewell Foundation. Besides this, soap and biscuits were distributed to 50 children of NGO Jamghat and 170 children through NGO Samarpan. 25 tubes of Odomos mosquito repellant was distributed to the community through NGO Samarpan.

## 340 CHILDREN WERE GIVEN DEWORMING TABLETS AND 590 CHILDREN WERE GIVEN VITAMIN-A TABLETS.

#### **GENERAL HEALTH AWARENESS**

- 286 women were educated on birth control measures, 127 children were educated on the importance of hand washing and 30 mothers were educated on MMR vaccination during the camps organised at our adopted village Dhakrani, Dehradun.
- A medical awareness camp was organised on November 19, at Rajakiye Inter College, Ukhimath (Uttarakhand). 220 students were counselled for optimum hygiene and use of cell phones.
- 700 children and parents watched a Puppet show on Health and Hygiene organized during the camp in association with NGO Project Concern International (Seemapuri and Sarai Kale Khan) and Sunaay Foundation in Vasant Kunj.

#### **HEALTH CAMPS FOR THE UNDERPRIVELEGED**

## WE HAVE REACHED OUT TO 177658 PEOPLE THROUGH 734 HEALTH CAMPS TO DATE.

- 58 Health Camps were organised in the month of November
- 8 biweekly health checkup camps in association with Bella Healthcare General Health Checkups conducted in upper and lower Dhakrani village, Dehradun. Free consultations and medicines were provided to 739 villagers.
- 6 general health checkup camps were organised reaching out to 730 people through our partner NGOs Gianelli Sadan, Feedback Foundation, Project Concern International, Samarpan and Youthreach covering village Deoli, Arjan Camp, Sarai Kale Khan and Kotla Mubarakpur in New Delhi and Raipur village and Suthana in Haryana.
- Monthly health checkup for children of NGO Jamghat conducted on November 19, for 50 children at their centre in Lado Sarai, New Delhi.
- A medical camp was organised by Dr. Chandan Ravi (in charge of the Health Centre, Ukhimath) on November 19, at Rajakiye Inter College, Ukhimath (Uttarakahnd). 220 students from standard VI to XII were examined. BP and blood sugar tests for the teachers (8) and staff (4) were done.
- A Multi Speciality camp was organized by Max India Foundation in association with Max Speciality Films and Max Healthcare, Mohali in village Toansa on November 21, 2015 benefitting 221 patients.





• Max India Foundation in collaboration with ILA Trust (an NGO which runs 3 mobile clinic vans) provided free medicines to 14813 needy people from the underserved communities of Delhi (Okhla, Jama Masjid, Ajmeri Gate, Baratooti, Shastri Park, GB Road, Turkman Gate, Sarai Khalil, Fahethpuri, Chawri Bazaar, Jamuna Bazaar and Lahori Gate) during the health camps.

#### **SUPPORT FOR SURGERIES AND TREATMENT**

## MAX INDIA FOUNDATION HAS SPONSORED 4715 SURGERIES AND TREATMENTS TO DATE.

Surgeries supported in the month of November:

- 5 paediatric cardiac surgeries were conducted by Dr. Dagar and team for children referred by Genesis Foundation and Afghan Red Crescent Society for surgical correction of congenital heart anomalies at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- A premature baby from our adopted village Dhakrani was given medical support at Max Hospital, Dehradun.
- MIF facilitated treatment for 8 patients suffering from different ailments including (fracture, cleft palate, dengue, trauma injury, heart surgery, brain tumor and hysteroscopic polypectomy) at Max Hospital in Dehradun, Bhatinda and Delhi (Patparganj, Gurgaon and Saket).
- A premature baby was provided conservative medical management at Max Hospital, Shalimar Bagh.
- 2 patients were treated for germ cell tumor and breast cancer at Max Hospital (Mohali and Patparganj in New Delhi).
- MIF in association with The Hans Foundation facilitated 3 cochlear implant surgeries at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- 19 cataract surgeries were facilitated through MIF at Max Hospital, Mohali.
- MIF facilitated free consultation for a young boy at Max Hospital, Patparganj.
- Medical consultation provided to 2 children referred by NGO Tara Homes at Max Hospital, Panchsheel.

#### REPRESENTATION AT VARIOUS FORUMS

 Uttarakhand 2020 Synergy Workshop was organised at Dehradun by The Hans Foundation on November 23, 2015 to bring synergy to the development efforts in the State. Mrs. Mohini Daljeet Singh (CEO - Max India Foundation) was invited due to the significant work MIF has done in the areas of social welfare and development in Uttarakhand. The workshop was inaugurated by Shri Harish Rawat, Honourable Chief Minister, Uttarakhand who felicitated representatives of organisations working in Uttarakahand, through CSR.
