HEALTH AWARENESS

Initiatives on Prevention of Dengue:

- 500 tubes of Odomos mosquito repellent were distributed to the community through NGO partners; Gianelli Sadan, GMR Foundation, Niveda and Project Concern International.
- 2,000 pamphlets (in Hindi) were distributed among the villagers during the camp in Dhakrani and Chandigarh.
- 2,000 pamphlets (in Hindi) were distributed among the villagers during the immunisation camps in Jhajjar, Mahendergarh and Rewari (in Haryana).
- 100 children and their parents were given a talk on dengue prevention during the immunisation camp organised in association with Project Concern International.

General Health Awareness

334 women were educated on reproductive health and hygiene, 40 on MMR, 9 children were educated on importance of hand washing and 7 on oral hygiene, 19 on nutrition, 11 were educated on first-aid, 7 were educated on environmental health during the camps organised in Dhakrani.

Counselling session on October 5 on General Health, Hygiene and Malnutrition in Kalimath, Ukhimath

Dr. Chandan Ravi (in-charge at Ukhimath Health Centre) along with Rashtriya Bal Swasthaya Karyakram team conducted a counselling session for 22 women on breastfeeding and family planning at Government Junior School, Kalimath. General health check-up was also done for the children. 53 children from standard 1st to 5th were checked for malnutrition and congenital anomaly.

SUPPORT FOR SURGERIES AND TREATMENT

Max India Foundation has sponsored 4,665 surgeries and treatments to date. A big thank you to all our doctors and their teams for their support. Surgeries supported in the month of October:

- 15 paediatric cardiac surgeries were conducted by Dr. Dagar and team for children referred and partly supported by Genesis Foundation and Afghan Red Crescent Society for surgical correction of congenital heart anomalies at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- MIF facilitated treatment for 6 patients suffering from different ailments including (fracture with cord compression, dengue, skin grafting, meningitis, conservative medical-management) at Max Hospital in Patparganj, Shalimar Bagh, Dehradun and Gurgaon.
- 4 oncology cases (Ca Breast, Ca Caecum, Ca Tongue and Non Hodgkin's Lymphoma) were treated at Max Hospital in Dehradun and New Delhi (Saket and Patparganj).
- MIF facilitated 5 cataract surgeries for cases referred by Samarpan Foundation at Max Hospital, Panchsheel.
- Free medical consultation provided to 4 children referred by NGO Jamghat at Max Hospital, Patparganj.
- MIF in association with The Hans Foundation facilitated 5 cochlear implant surgeries at Max Hospital,
 East Block, Saket.
