## Awareness on Prevention of Dengue



- Puppet shows were organised for **600** children and their parents in association with NGOs Chetanalaya, Sshrishti Learning Centre and Sunaay Foundation.
- **15000** Pamphlets (in Hindi) were distributed in various underserved communities of Delhi and NCR through our partner NGOs.
- **502** people were given a talk on dengue prevention during the multispeciality camps organised in association with MSF in Punjab and Max Healthcare in Greater Noida.

## General Health Awareness

**20** women were educated on importance of nutrition, **113** children were educated on importance of hand washing, **85** women were educated on birth control measures, **195** on unsafe abortion, **197** women were educated on mental health and **16** children were educated on oral hygiene during the camps organised in Dhakrani.

## SUPPORT FOR SURGERIES AND TREATMENT

- In September, **9** paediatric cardiac surgeries were conducted by Dr. Dagar and team for children referred by Genesis Foundation and Afghan Red Crescent Society for surgical correction of congenital heart anomalies at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- MIF facilitated treatment for **13** patients suffering from different ailments including (respiratory distress, fractured arm, coronary artery disease, dengue, trauma injury due to accident, renal disease, CHD, heart ailment laminectomy surgery and valve replacement surgery) at Max Hospitals (Patparganj, Bhatinda, Dehradun, Mohali, Gurgaon, Saket and Shalimar Bagh).
- **3** oncology cases (CA tongue, CA rectum and germ cell tumour of the brain) were treated at Max Hospitals (Bhatinda in Punjab, Shalimar Bagh and Saket in New Delhi.)
- MIF facilitated free consultations (Dermatologist and ENT) for **2** children referred by NGO Tara Homes at Max Hospital, Panchsheel.
- MIF in association with The Hans Foundation facilitated **3** cochlear implant surgeries at Max Hospital, East Block, Saket.
- **9** Pap smear tests were conducted at Max Hospital, West Block, Saket and mammography conducted for **1** patient at Max Hospital, Patpargang (these cases were identified at the cancer screening camps organised in Delhi.)
- A young girl referred by NGO Feedback Foundation was provided medical care at Max Hospital, Saket.
- An abandoned child was given immediate medical care at Max Hospital, Noida.
