

ARTIFICIAL LIMBS AND POLIO CALIPERS CAMP 7th—11th April at Mohali

Max India Foundation organized its **6th Artificial Limbs and Polio Calipers camp** at Gurudwara Gur Shabad Parkash Akal Ashram, Sohana. People from across Punjab came with a lot of hope and aspirations to walk again on their own and get a new lease to life. There were more than 250 registrations. 127 polio calipers, 112 artificial limbs, 48 crutches and 3 modified shoes were given to the needy people. The prosthetics were manufactured at the camp site. Volunteers from Max Specialty Films served the patients. Members from Max Healthcare and Max Life also joined in along with NCC cadets in full support and ensured the camp was conducted smoothly. They encouraged the patients to walk and get used to their limbs.

Health Camps

- 4 April : An Eye Check up camp was organized at Harchandpur Government School in Rewari district, under the AIS - Youthreach, Integrated Community Development Programme. Total 350 patients were examined. 55 children were examined for viral fever, cold cough, anemia, etc by Dr Sandip Sriram Badgujar (Dept of Pediatrics) from Max Hospital, Saket. A total no of 190 patients (40Male & 150 Female) were examined for Eye ailments by Ameen Rehman (Optometrist) from Max Hospital, Panchsheel. Medicines were given to the patients along with refreshments.
- 9 April : Regular health check up conducted by Dr Satyanarayan Reddy from Max Hospital, Saket for 38 children from NGO Jamghat centre at Old Delhi.
- 9 April : Eye and General Health camp in Nekpur village, Ghaziabad: Optometrist Bini and Dr Priyesh checked 200 people. BP and weight was taken and free medicines were given.
- 15 April : Eye Camp with NGO Child Survival India at Tikri Khurd Village: 80 patients were examined by Optometrist Ameen Rehman. 13 patients were identified for cataract surgery. 5 cataract surgeries were conducted at Max Hospital Shalimar Bagh through MIF.
- 16 April : Health camp for the underprivileged women with NGO Rasta in Khoda, Ghaziabad: 80 women were screened and given medicines. Dr. Sonika from Max Healthcare Patparganj conducted the check ups.

- 23 April : General Health camp for 80 people from NGO Child Survival India at Tikri Khurd. Dr Akshay Kashyap from Max Hospital, Shalimar Bagh conducted the check ups. BP, weight and random blood sugar tests were done and free medicines were given to the needy.
- 24 April : Free Health camp organized at Prayas health services, Kirti Nagar. Dr Kumar checked 100 patients. Free medicines were provided to the needy.
- 25 April : Health check camp with NGO Child Survival India Narela: Dr Anupam Priyadarshiee (Internal Medicine) and Dr Garima Kaur (Gynecologist) from Max Hospital, Shalimar Bagh conducted check ups for 200 patients. Blood sugar, BP and weight were checked and free medicines were given.

Total number of people benefitted through health camps to date: 66185

Spectacles distribution: 45 patients who were identified during the last medical camp organized by MIF through Max Specialty Films Limited and Max Hospital, Mohali in village Paniali were given spectacles on 28 April. Mr. SP Bansal, Associate Vice President – HR and Dr. SMS Sidhu, in charge, Max Health Centre, Rail Majra gave away the spectacles in presence of village Sarpanch. Dr. Sidhu also educated the beneficiaries on proper usage of the spectacles.
