## **HEALTH CAMPS**

#### MULTI SPECIALTY CAMPS - FIVE

- MIF in association with AIS Youthreach organized 2 Multi Specialty Health Check Camps:
  - A) 10 December in **Patuhera village**, Rewari. Dr Rahul Upreti (Internal Medicine), Dr Amit (Pediatrician), Sri. Om (Optometrist) conducted checkups for 280 people. Free medicines were provided to the needy.
  - B) 17 December in **Naichaina village**, Rewari. Dr Meenakshi (Internal Medicine), Ameen Rehman (Optometrist), Dr Rahul (Pediatrician) and Dr Mukesh (GP) checked 410 people. Free medicines were also provided.
- 11 December: Max India Foundation conducted a Multi Specialty Camp at **Chakkarpur village**, Gurgaon with NGO Humana People to People. Dr Alpana (ENT), Dr Vinu (Gynecologist) and Dr Abhishek (Pediatrician) and Dr Chandan (GP) conducted check ups for 40 people. Free medicines were also given.
- 13 December: 200 people were checked at a Multi Specialty camp organized in association with Rotary Club of Sainik Farms at **Deoli village**. Dr Neha Sethi (ENT), Dr Amit (Cardiologist), Dr Baseerat (GP) and Dr. Rahul (Pediatrician) conducted the check ups. BP, Sugar, ECG and weight were also checked. Free medicines were provided.
- A Multi Speciality Medical Camp was conducted on 27 December in village **Rail Majra**. Dr. Ashok Gupta (Internal medicine), Dr. Devesh Kumar (Cardiology) and Dr. Tania Bhalla (Gynaecology) of Max Hospital, Mohali examined 206 people. Ms. Saruchi from department of Ophthalmology identified patients for cataract surgeries. Free medicines were also given.

#### **EYE CAMP - ONE**

12 December: MIF in association with NGO Rasta organized an Eye camp for 120 girls at **Ghazipur**, Delhi. 6 girls identified with refraction errors were provided spectacles later.

#### **ENT/ DENTAL CAMPS - TWO**

- 4 December: MIF and NGO Nav Abhiyan organized an ENT and Dental check up camp at **Jangpura**, New Delhi. Dr Neha Sethi (ENT) and Dr Mayur (Dentist) conducted check ups for 120 girls.
- 24 December: 120 children residing in AICB Blind School on **Sohna Road** were checked by Dr Varun Malu (ENT) and Dr. Mayura (BDS).

### GENERAL HEALTH CHECK CAMPS - TWENTY FOUR

MIF conducted 24 camps in association with its partner NGOs: AISSJ, Tata Power, CRSNF, GMR Foundation, AVON, Feedback Foundation, Banjara Mahila and Jamghat. These camps were organized at the following locations; Hapur, Rohini, SAVDA Ghera, Faridabad, Old Delhi, Nala Colony, Dwarka, Greater Kailash, Bihari Colony, Todapur, Zakhira, Jawahar camp, Ferozshah Kotla, Jahangirpuri, Palam Gaon, Kirti Nagar, Gareeb basti, Moti Nagar, Bawana, Rail Majra and Badli. 2967 people were provided free of cost consultations, medicines and BP and blood sugar was also checked.
