Health Camps

This month Max India Foundation has introduced a new initiative to add value to its Health and Immunization camps. This is the introduction of a **puppet show** on the theme of health and hygiene. The puppet show was performed at 3 camps and received a thunderous response. For this, Max India Foundation has joined hands with ENACTUS, **the social service group of Shri Ram College of Commerce** who are promoting the puppeteers of Katputli Colony. While spreading the message of hygiene for health, the puppeteers are able to earn a living.

A **Multi Specialty Health Check Camp** was organized on 1 Feb. in Devli village in association with **Rotary Club of Sainik Farms** for 400 people. Dr. Sandip (Paediatric), Dr Hari Yadav (Internal Medicine) and Sri Om (Optometrist) conducted the camp. Random Blood Sugar, Weight and BP were checked and free medicines were provided. Volunteer Aashik Jain of Max Actuarial was a great help with registrations and crowd management. Thank you!



A general health camp in association with NGO Rasta and Delhi State Aids Control Society (DSACS) was organized for the laborers of Ghazipur Mandi on 25 Feb. Dr Hemender (Internal Medicine) from Max Healthcare Patparganj conducted the check ups for 125 laborers. Free medicines were provided to the needy.

A general health camp was organized in association with NGO Youth Reach at Harchandpur village, Rewari on 26 Feb. 350 people were registered. Dr Prerna (Gynecologist), Dr Rajeev Upreti (Internal Medicine), and Dr Priyadarshi Amit (Orthopedic) along with 3 nurses from Max Healthcare, Saket examined the patients. Random blood sugar test, BP check and free medicines were provided in the camp.

A health check camp was organized on 28 Feb. in association with NGO Child Survival India at Narela. Dr. Sudhir Kumar (Orthopedic) from Max Healthcare Saket conducted the camp. 250 registrations were done and free medicines were given.
