Rittana Children Foundation, **Greater Noida**, 30 Jan: 56 children children were given Hep B dose, 20 children were given DPT and 10 children were given DT vaccination.

Health Camps

A General Health check camp was organized in association with **NGO Earth Saviors, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi** on 9th Jan 2014. Dr. Satyanarayana Reddy (Pediatric) and Dr. Baseerat (Internal Medicine) from Max Hospital, Saket checked 160 patients. Free medicines were also given.

Max Super Specialty Hospital Mohali organized a Free Medical camp at Shri Nada Sahib Gurudwara on 19th Jan 2014. 300 visitors to the gurudwara were provided free consultation by Dr. V.S Sachdev (Internal Medicine), Dr. Sumit Mahajan (Ortho), Dr. Shabjot Dhillon (Gynae) & Technician Nandini (Eye). Besides this, free BP, blood sugar, weight, bone densitometry test, ambulance cover and free medicines were also provided.
