## **Immunization camps:**

15 Immunization camps were organized in the month of July in association with NGO partners: All India Society for Social Justice, Finnovation, Setu, Rasta, Prayas, Salaam Baalak Trust, Deenbandhu Primary School, Khushi Shikshantara, Guru Nanak Garib Niwas Society, Aashlayam, Sanskar School and Vidya and Child in Delhi, Ghaziabad, Noida and Siliguri.

## **Health Camps:**

- A health camp conducted on 3 July at Prayas health centre, Kirti Nagar where 100
  patients were examined and given free medicines.
- Regular health check conducted for 24 children of NGO Jamghat at their Lado Sarai centre on 4 July by Dr. Joseph (Pediatrician) from Max Hospital, Saket.
- A health check camp was organized with NGO Feedback Foundation on 11 July at Nala Colony, Vasant Kunj. Dr.Rajeev Upreti (Internal medicine) from Max Hospital Saket and two nurses conducted the check ups for 120 people.
- An Eye check camp and general health check camp was organized on 16 July in association with Vibhuti Welfare Society in R.K.Puram. 100 patients were given consultations by Dr. Manish (Internal Medicine) from Max Hospital, Saket. Optometrist Bini (Max Medcentre Panchsheel) conducted the eye check ups. Free medicines were provided and Blood Pressure and weight checked.
- Eye and Orthopedic check up conducted on 17 July for 100 elderly patients at Recreation centre for the elderly, Delhi Brotherhood Society, Sunder Nagri by Optometrist: Ameen Rehman (Max Medcentre Panchsheel) and Dr. Neeraj Gupta (Orthopedic Surgeon) Max Hospital, Patparganj. Free medicines and spectacles were given to the needy. Random Blood Sugar, Blood Pressure and weight checked.
- A health camp for women was organized in association with Shine Foundation on 18
  July at Gijhore Village, Noida. Dr. Sonia from Max Hospital, Patparganj checked 100
  women. Random Blood Sugar, Blood Pressure and weight checked and free medicines
  were given to the needy.
- A health camp was organized in association with NGO Prayas on 24 July at Jahangirpuri. 100 children were checked by Dr Vijay (Pediatrician) from Max Hospital, Shalimar Bagh. Free medicines were also provided to the children.
- A health camp was organized in association with Global Hunt Foundation on 31 July at Dadri. 150 people were screened by Dr Meenakshi (Internal Medicine) and Dr Preety (Gynecologist) from Max Hospital, Saket. 2 nurses helped with Random Blood Sugar test, Blood Pressure and weight. Free medicines were provided to the needy.
