Max Raphael Partnership Month in Dehradun: Max India Foundation observed its 4th Annual Max Raphael Partnership month in March. Besides regular activity to benefit the specially-abled community of Raphael Centre, immunization camps were jointly organized in outreach areas at two locations; Hassanpur and Sherpur. 402 children were immunized with MMR. Dr Manish Tomar from Max Hospital, Dehradun was the keynote speaker at a seminar organized on Disability.



Max India Foundation partnered and sponsored the Medical check up camp on board "Life Line Express", at Guna, MP from 22 to 24 March 2014. Dr Mohan Bhargava (Cardiologist) from Max Super Speciality Hospital, Saket and his team conducted cardiac check ups for 642 patients. Total 10603 OPD's were conducted during the camp. Max India Foundation sponsored medicines for the camp.

Immunization camps

- 6th March Shine Foundation, **Noida**: 100 children were given MMR vaccine. A health talk on dental care, hygiene and health foods was also given.
- •13th March, NGO SETU, **Nithari village, Noida:** 100 children were immunized with Ist dose of Hep B, 20 children were given DT and 20 were given Td vaccination.
- 14th March, Gianelli Sadan, **Sangam Vihar, Delhi**: 100 children were given MMR vaccination. 100 Vitamin A 1st dose and deworming tablets were also given.
- •NGO Prayas, **Kirti Nagar**: 30 children were given Hep B dose, 30 typhoid shots, 20 MMR and 20 DT shots, Vitamin A 1st dose and deworming tablets were given.
- 15th March, NGO SOIL, **Gurgaon**: 100 children were given typhoid vaccination, Vitamin A and deworming tablets at Rao Ram Public School. A puppet show on Health and Hygiene was organized for the children.
- 20th March: Happy School, **Gurgaon**: 100 children were given Td vaccination.

21st March: NGO Prayas, Jahangirpuri: 100 children were given Hep B 2nd dose.

- Raphael outreach centre, **Hassanpur**, **Uttarakhand**: 137 children immunized with MMR.
- 24 March, NGO Vidya and Child, Sec 37, **Noida:** 100 children were given Hep B 2nd dose and 70 children were given Hep B 1st dose.

25th March, Steria High School, **Noida:** 99 children were given MMR shots with deworming tablets.

26th March, Purkul Youth Development Society, **Dehradun:** 37 children were given Hep B 3rd dose.

Health Camps

- A health check camp was organized with NGO Prayas in Kirti Nagar on 4th March. Dr. Shirin Chaurasia from Max Hospital, Shalimar Bagh conducted the camp for over 100 patients. Free medicines were also given.
- A regular health check was conducted for 24 children of NGO Jamghat at their Lado Sarai centre on 6th March. Dr. Reddy from Max Hospital, Saket conducted the check ups.
- A health check camp organized on 7th March in association with Vibhuti Welfare Trust, Munirka, New Delhi. Dr. Narendra Verma (Internal Medicine) and optometrist Bini checked from Max Hospital, Saket checked 150 patients. Free medicines were also given.

@ Max Speciality Films on 8th March A special health check up camp for the women of village Rail Majra was organized. It was inaugurated by Dr. SK Pathak (SMO, Balachaur). Dr. SMS Sidhu and Mrs. Narinder Kaur, Incharge Sub Centre, checked 70 women and 38 blood tests were done. They were educated on the importance of a healthy diet. Free medicines were given to the needy.

• 3 health check camps for underprivileged women were organized in association with partner NGOs. 19th March with NGO Samarpan at Kotla Mubarakpur, 26 March with NGO Steria Foundation in Chilla Khadar, Yamuna Pushta and 27th March with NGO SPYM in Munirka Total 320 women were screened. As a special initiative CBC and peripheral smear examination along with consultations for women was conducted and a talk on health, menstruation and hygiene was given. The doctors also gave a talk on breast self examination and breast cancer. Free sanitary pads and bathing soap were distributed. A team of doctors, nurses and lab technicians from Max Hospital Patparganj and Max Hospital Gurgaon conducted the camp.
