On the occasion of Max Raphael Partnership Month, Max India Foundation collaborated with Manav Seva Sannidhi (MSS) to facilitate its 7th Artificial Limbs and Polio Calipers Camp from 25th —28th November at Raphael Centre, Dehradun.

A total of 306 patients from Dehradun, Mussourie and surrounding villages attended the camp. 119 artificial limbs, 180 calipers, 5 crutches and 2 MCR sandals were given away to the patients. 48 volunteers from Max entities in Dehradun – Max Life Insurance, Max Healthcare, Antara Senior Living and Max Enterprise relentlessly provided unconditional support for all 4 days. Health Camps:

- 12th November - Monthly health check up of 45 children of NGO Jamghat conducted by Dr.Kiran of Max Hospital, Saket.
- 13th November - A camp organized in association with NGO Feedback Foundation in Gosia village. Dr. Amit of Max Homecare conducted check-ups of 80 people. Two nurses of Max Hospital, Patparganj carried out sugar and BP checks for these people.
- 13th November - General health check up camp conducted for 100 people at Kirti Nagar, Delhi in association with NGO Prayas. Free medicines were also provided.
- 14 November - Pediatric health check up camp for 120 children was organized in association with NGO Prayas at Jahangirpuri.
- 18th November - Health camp organized in association with AIS - Youth Reach, Integrated Community Development Program at Bawal Dhani village in Rewari district in Haryana. 310 patients were screened, and free medicines were provided.150 people were examined by an ENT specialist, 80 children by a Paediatrician and 90 women examined by a Gynaecologist.
- 19th November - General Health check camp organized at Noida in association with Art of Living. Dr Rohit from Max Homecare conducted check ups for 120 people.

- 19th November - Health camp organized in association with AVON at Manav Rachna International School, Faridabad. Dr. Rohit from Max Homecare and two nurses from Max Patparganj conducted check up of 80 individuals. Sugar test and BP were also checked.
- 21st November - Health Camp organized with NGO Savera in West Vinod Nagar. Dr. Jyoti (Gynecologist) and Dr. Gaurav (Orthopedic) from Max Hospital Saket and Dr. Rohit from Max Homecare along with nurses from Max Hospital Patparganj conducted check-ups for 250 patients. Medicines were distributed in the camp. Puppeteers performed shows on health and hygiene and on prevention of Dengue.
- 21st November - General check up and Cardiac check up camp organized in association with NGO Vibhuti at R.K.Puram, Delhi. Dr Basirat and Dr Naveen from Max Hospital, Saket conducted check ups for 180 people.
- 25th November - Pediatric and general check up camp organized with NGO Youth Reach in Rewari. Dr Kiran (Pediatrician) and Dr Rahul (General Physician) from Max Hospital, Saket conducted check ups for 200 people.
- 26th November - General health check up conducted for 24 children of NGO Jamghat in their Lado Sarai Centre by Dr. Rahul from Max Homecare.
- 26th November - Pediatric and General check up camp organized with NGO Chetnalaya at New Seemapuri. Dr Amit and Dr. Rohit (General Physicians of Max Home care team) and Dr Kumar (Pediatrician) conducted the check ups for 200 people. Free medicines were also given.
- 27th November - Health camp organized with AVON at Sector 14, Faridabad. Dr. Rohit of Homecare and nurses of Max Hospital, Saket conducted check ups for 75 patients. Medicines were also distributed for common ailments.
- 27th November - Children health check camp organized with NGO Rasta at Ghazipur. Dr Amit from Max Homecare conducted check ups for 100 children.

Immunization camps:
